We honour the pouring tradition...

In the Purification, your bartender will always use a glass cleaned, then rinsed with cold water, allowing the glass to reach the same temperature as the beer...

II the Sacrifice, ensuring every drop of beer is fresh, your bartender allows the first foams from the tap to wash away...

III the Liquid Alchemy Begins, the chalice is held at 45 degree angle allowing the perfect amount of foam to start forming the head of the beer...

IV the Head, the glass is straightened and the head forms creating the vital protection for the beer ensuring maximum freshness and flavour...

V the Removal, your bartender then closes the tap in one swift motion and moves the glass away to prevent drips entering the beer that have had contact with the air, these drops have oxidized and are not worthy of your beer...

VI the Beheading, while the head is still forming, your bartender cuts it gently with a knife to eliminate the larger bubbles, bursting easily they accelerate the dissipation of the head...

VII the Cleansing, your bartender rinses the bottom and sides of your glass, this keeps the outside of the chalice clean and comfortable to hold...

VIII the Bestowal, your beer is served to you on a coaster.

Golden Ale & Blondes...

Leffe Blonde

Abv ml
6.6% 330ml

Rolling sweetness that throws out honey like properties, clean esters of alcohol with mild hop fruitiness & a long sweet herbal finish. *food complement*

Dupont Meinnie Blonde

8.5% 330ml

This coppery blonde has fine hop aromas, and a superb bitter-sweet balance. Although not advertised as a Saison, this beer still displays many characteristics of the farmhouse style. Under the radar and full of flavour, you should check it out.

La Chouffe

8.0% 330/750

Champagne like mouth feel & spiced caramel aroma are the highlights of this blonde. Dry pale malt character. Light hops. A burst of peach in the palate. This is the flagship ale from Brasserie D'Chouffe for a good reason.

Judas

8.5% 330ml

Has aromas of apples, pears & dry hay. A rolling smoothness with a bitter sweet palate. Persistent crispness and balanced alcohol at the finish. A quirky beer that is highly underrated, like a Duvel with added funk!

Delirium Tremens

8.5% 330ml

Brewed by the Huyghe Brewery, this beer is of fine manufacture and was voted WBA "Best Beer in the world" in 1997. Conceived from 3 different yeasts, it presents a beautiful colour, blonde/coppery as well as a compact abundant head. The beer has a nose of wheat and barley with traces of coriander and orange. Full and round in the mouth it is spicy, with a pleasant bitterness. Drink enough and you will see pink elephants!

Duvel-Highly recommended

8.5% 330/750

The king of Belgian golden ales. Apple skin, clean alcohol & slight yeast in the aroma. Cleansing crispness. Flashes of yeast hop bitterness & alcohol hit the palate. Whipped up early last century, on first tasting it was described as "a real devil", hence its name. The beer is hopped with Styrian Goldings, Saaz and uses McEwans yeast.

Barbar Blonde

8.0% 330ml

Born of the ancestral know-how of a family brewery, the famous Brasserie Lefebvre, Barbar beer will please you with its malt taste and subtle flavour of honey. It is brewed using water drawn from artesian wells on the site of the brewery, at Quenast, a small village to the south of Brussels.

Gouden Carolus Classic

8.5% 330ml

Light molasses and a soft herbal aroma up-front. Quite the roasted, malty sweet beer. Rough with a dirty-earth edge. Sharp peaking bitterness riding off a crisp carbonation. Leafy, dry mouth feel. Herbal character is quite tea-like when blended with the sweet malts of chocolate, caramel and molasses. Distinct clove backbone, with spicy warming alcohol.

Affligem Blonde

6.8% 330ml

Words that describe this beer; peppery, spicy, floral, sharp, sweet, biscuity, Upon opening this beer, it was obvious that it is going to be good. With a great head that sticks around for a while and the hint of honey makes this beautiful blonde an anytime beer. Try me before I'm all gone.

St Feuillien Blonde

7.5% 330ml

A palate pleaser, this beer is a deep golden colour with a smooth frothy head. A well-perfumed beer with citrus and strong malty taste, it's sure to be a crowd favourite. It has hits of rhubarb, a tarty fruitiness and it can be slightly bitter and dry, but leaves a nice lacing around your glass

Piraat 9

9% 330ml

Shiver me timbers. Piraat pours clear golden, medium white head. Intriguing phenolic and earthy aroma, with floral hops, honey, and some alcohol. Medium bodied, moussy carbonation. A bit sweet, medium bitter finish.

Food complement – strong seafood, soft cheese, fruit desserts or as an aperitif.

Brunes & Ambers...

Affligem Dubbel

Abv **ml**
6.8% 330ml

Dessert any one? I will take fruit cake. This beer has hits of raisins, cherries, plum, chocolate, pears, a winner in the fruit cake lovers book. With a pleasant aroma and creamy carbonation this beer will make you feel all warm and fuzzy!

Barbar Bok

8.0% 330ml

When this beer is opened you may get caramel, cardamom, honey, herbs & spices, when you try this beer you will taste chocolate, bananas, over ripe fruit. This beer is unlike other dark beers, it is lightly carbonated with a coarse mouth feel.

De Dolle Oerbier -Highly recommended

9.0% 330ml

This Strong Belgian Dark Ale is exotic, fiery & out control. Deep tawny brown with a creamy tiny bubbled head. Fantastic lacing. Phenols of caramelised granny smith apples, tart berries and lemon grain. Hints of liquorice & spice. Silky smooth beyond belief. Full Bodied with a dominant malt mass. Earthy currents/ripe blood orange flavours are present late in the palate along with weathered grassy hop phenols. This beer is A+ in all departments Get one now!

Dupont Moinette Brune

8.5% 330ml

A beautifully balanced brune that is super easy to drink. Solid caramel aromas with hints of Belgian yeast poke through the sturdy tan coloured head. Flavours are caramel, toffee, mild sweetness & cloaked alcohol. A highly underrated beer from the small family Brewery of Dupont.

Gulden Draak

10.5% 330ml

The Golden Dragon, Dark, sweet and complex. Flavours of dates and spices, heavy alcohol and great carbonation. This is one for the brave powerfull flavours and a high abv, be challenged.

Hoegaarden Forbidden Fruit

8.5% 330ml

Back in house after a long absence. Hoegaarden forbidden fruit is a crafty flavour mix of stewed blackcurrants with warm toasty malts and a lingering bitterness that is quite pronounced for a Belgian Ale. Be bad, have one.

Kwak

8.4% 330ml

Mr Pauwel (Paul) Kwak created this fine brew in 1791. Paul is said to have been an Innkeeper who made his own beer and served it in an old stirrup cup, so the coachmen would not have to get off their horse to drink. His recipe has not changed over time and this double fermented beer continues to entice with hints of vanilla, lime and a sweet caramel finish balancing the overall dryness. Rum 'n' raisin & a steely malt husk flavour pepper the end of the palate.

La Gauloise Brune

8.1% 330ml

Aromas of dark malts, toffee, fortified wine & a rich scent of coriander. Loaded with toffee, sultana & chocolate flavours.

La Gauloise Ambre

5.5% 330ml

Rustic citrus aroma, remnants of raisin bread crust. Fermented fruit salad washes over the tongue leaving a full malt body to linger.

Leffe Brune

6.5% 330ml

Contrasts the brown sugar sweetness of roasted barley with a strong bitter taste. It's a rich, almost black beer served with a creamy head. Coffee finish on the palate, it is the after dinner drink of beers.

Leffe Radieuse

8.2% 330ml

Like its cousin Brune, Leffe Radieuse has a full-bodied taste with fruity flavours. However this golden brown ale delivers a more powerful, bitter caramel flavour complemented by hints of pepper. The word Radieuse means 'HALO'.

Leffe Vielle Cuvee	8.2%	330ml
The top of the range from Leffe. Leffe Vieille Cuvée combines a very complex taste pallet and the fruity flavours of banana, citrus fruit, coriander and cloves, with a mild sharpness. It is a beer to drink instead of complex wines,		
Mc Chouffe	8.0%	330/750
The blondes' younger brother, the "Mc", has a balanced palate of roasted caramel malts, Belgian spices, & warming alcohol. Quite dry at the finish with robust crispness. Pronounced "Shoof" characteristics. Garden gnomes have been on this for years and loving it.		
Malhuer 12	12.0%	330ml
Malhaur means "bad luck" but none to be had here. This is a BIG beer. Rum-soaked raisin aroma with some fresh-baked molasses cake in the back. Carbonation comes to play with a sizable bite. Heavy malt character with the spicy, peppery alcohol.. Finishes semisweet with a kiss of charred malt.		
Nocturnum	9.0%	330ml
The Tremens dark cousin. Nocturnum has a sinister ruby red appearance with creamy tan head. Smooth & velvety on the palate, up front sweetness, mild apple tartness, medicinal herb, spicy alcohol & grain in the dry finish. Turn to the Delirium Dark Side!!!		
St Bernardus Abt 12	10.0%	330/750ml
Abt means "highest rank" and 12 denotes the gravity at which the beer was finalised. Deep mature brown in colour. Lacing present. Aromas of clove, ripe fruit, malt sweetness. Taste is amazing; waves of malt sweetness intermittent with juicy dark fruits and buttery cake qualities. Alcohol spikes through in the mid palate then slides back into the impressive complex body that is super balanced. Exceptionally smooth & creamy. To be sipped all night and savoured as one of the finest ales to ever grace our shores. In the category of super heavy beers, this surely represents the pinnacle. This beer follows the same recipe, uses the same water and its hops comes from the same hop regions as Westvleteren.		
St Bernardus Prior 8	8.0%	330ml
This is a big beer! Big flavours, big taste, big malts. Sweet finish, with a nutty like aroma, this beer is warm with a real twang, finishes with alcohol warmth at the end. Given the size of this beers flavour, no doubt it is one meal-sized beer.		
St Bernardus Pater 6	6.7%	330ml
Classed as a dubbel this pater bier pours a rustic brown with a billowy tan head. Not overly carbonated, the head dissipates quickly to form a tight cap to protect the beer. Raisins, ripe plums, figs, & candied sugar aromas are subtle & in balance. Creamy sweetness, then tart fruitiness work the palate.		
St Fuellien Brune	7.5%	330ml
A palate pleaser, this beer is a deep golden colour with a smooth frothy head. A well-perfumed beer with citrus and and strong malty taste, its sure to be a crowd favourite. It has hits of rhubarb, a tart fruitiness and it can be slightly bitter and dry, but leaves a nice lacing around your glass		

Food complement - game, red meats, smoked or barbequed foods, rich desserts, sharp cheeses or as a digestive.

Triples...

DeKoninck Tripel

Abv	ml
8.5%	330ml

From Antwerp. This tripel is particularly simple and fresh. Mild bitterness and Belgian yeast give way to punchy pineapple finish.

Dendermonde Tripel

8%	330ml
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Fresh fruit and bready malt aroma. Fruity, mild yeast, with an aniseed finish. Moderate carbonation. A well regarded tripel.

Karmeliet Tripel -Highly recommended

8.4%	330ml
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Tripel Karmeliet pours an interesting gold-amber-ish color. Carbonation is very active and yields a huge, vanilla coloured head. Flavour is a delicate mix of clove and pepper complemented by mellow pear with some grainy notes to round it out. WBA worlds best beer 2008.

La Guillotine

8.5%	330ml
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From the famed Huyghe brewery the makers of Nocturnum and Delirium Tremens. Light bodied for a tripel but packs a bunch of flavour sweet and sour fruits, light spice and very nice.

Leffe Tripel

8.4%	330ml
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Leffe Triple is golden and hazey, with cedary, rose-like notes and a full aftertaste of spicy coriander and orange. Leffe Triple is an excellent replacement for any robust or full-flavored white wine.

St Bernardus Tripel

8.0%	330ml
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Apricot, sweet toffee & tropical fruits are flavours that will hit your nose, with a solid dry character. This is full, malty, fluffy, sweet, spicy, mildly bitter, and mildly hoppy, leaving a party of flavours in your mouth. The flavours become intense as it warms, must try!

St Feuillien Triple

8.5%	330ml
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Quite the character! The head is big, white, smooth and compact, which lets of a fragrance Full of hops, spices, fruits and like a fresh bouquet on the nose. The taste lingers and leaves you wanting more of the maltiness and unique aroma.

Food complement - pork, oily fish, poultry, bbq, sharp cheeses.

Blanche De Namur -Highly recommended

Bocq Brewery award winning wit. WBA worlds best wheat beer 2008. Cloudy with lemon citrus, very light wheat esters and superbly refreshing.

Hoegaarden White

4.9%	330ml
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Orange zest, white pepper, & coriander dominate the nose. Slightly sweet. The yeast creates a pepper flavour that complements the sour hop character.

St Bernardus Wit

5.5%	330ml
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A genuine wheat beer from the Bernardus stable. Light to med body. Mature lemon/banana aromas. A palate of full flavoured wheats, simple spices, & curacao phenols. Wonderfully smooth to the very end. Arguably, one of the best wheat beers in the world today.

Belgian Pale Ale...

De Dolle Arabier

Abv ml

8.0% 330ml

Arabier is a pure malt beer brewed by 'the mad brewers' De Dolle Brouwers. Arabier is bitter! So if you don't like bitter then this beer is not for you. It has big hop bitterness with banana and citrus characteristics. This beer pours with a big head, creamy top and with a long lasting taste. This beer has gone from generation to generation and has the personality to go with it

Hopus Belgian IPA

8.5% 375ml

From Lefebvre. Hopous is mildly bitter for the style, Big Belgian yeast flavour. As is typical with Belgian IPA, the hop bitterness is not over the top. Try it served with the last firth of the bottle served in a shot glass on the side. A nice alternative to the typically sweeter Belgian styles.

Houblon Chouffe Tripel IPA

9.0% 750ml

An 'India Pale Ale' styled beer that originated in 2006, a second fermented beer with hazy golden colour. When poured you find a big white fluffy head and a amazing taste underneath it. Notes of apple, banana, melon, with a zesty hop finish. With a good dose of carbonation and a refreshing taste, you will be back for more!

Food complement -beef, bbq, sharp cheeses, spicy food.

Saisons...

Dupont Bons Voeux -Highly recommended

9.5% 750ml

Hazy gold with a big, lasting head. Aromas of hoppy bread, Belgian yeast & spice, hay sheds & malts. Flavour; Bread-like to begin with then the alcohol pokes through the yeast and subtle jammy fruit phenols. Massive carbonation. Super dry finish. Once a beer brewed solely for the staff of the brewery as a Christmas specialty, The Bons has made its mark internationally as a great saison. Very Dupont . . .Very Good.

Dupont Cervesia

8.0% 750ml

Creamy-textured, semi-sour sweet & caramel maltiness, lemon/apple fruitiness & compelling wood finish. A unique brew by anyone's standards. Great to share with friends after a feast. A Belgian blonde/Saison hybrid.

Saison Dupont

6.5% 330/750

Earthy, ripe pear & solid herbal backbone rounds out the nose. A touch of fruitiness & musty chalky yeast. Smooth with dry grain in the finish. Unyielding carbonation. Light/med body. Drink on hot day's ice cold. WBA Worlds Best Beer in 2007.

Silly Saison

5.0% 330ml

Pours a rustic brown with a thick chunky head. Aromas of brown sugar & fresh malt. Not a traditional saison; rarely seen this is a brown ale saison hybrid. Flavours of rich malts dominate, while a slight tang disguised as crispness, creates a solid finish. An underrated little beer that just keeps on giving.

Food complement - soft cheese, salad, poultry

From the Hands of the Trappist Monks...

Achelle Brune Extra (TRAPPIST)	9.5%	330ml
Pours a rich brown. Pumpernickel bread, rich malts and dark fruits are all present in the nose, along with a traditional yeast aroma. This beer has a palate rich with treacle, raisins & dark berries. Alcohol is well hidden; a balanced Trappist ale reminiscent of a Westmalle Tripel.		
Chimay Rouge (TRAPPIST)	7.0%	330
This dubbel is a very well rounded ale with delicious candied sugar and a hint of red apple, as well as Belgian yeasts, are noticeable on the nose. There is a big candied sugar carry over from the aroma then a kick of spice (clove or even rosemary-like), malt and bread flavour from the yeast. Lingering spiciness.		
Chimay White (TRAPPIST)	8.0%	330ml
Typified by its golden colour and often-cloudy appearance, Chimay White is the last of this range. The 'White Cap' was first brewed by Father Theodore in 1966 and is classed as a triple. Characterised by its scent, which comes from a combination of fresh hops and yeast with hints of Muscat and dry grapes giving it a distinctive aroma. With almost no bitterness, this beer has a soft finish with a dense, creamy mouth-feel.		
Chimay Grand Reserve (TRAPPIST)	9.0%	330/750
This vintage beer is corked in the bottle just like fine wine. Try it on your own or share with good friends. This aromatic rich, lively rich ale has a medium-sweet middle, with gently drier suggestions of thyme, pepper, sandalwood and nutmeg in the finish. The most well known Trappist beer in the world. An extremely smooth mouth feel and finish; typical of the		
La Trappe Tripel (TRAPPIST)	10.0%	750ml
Dark amber in appearance. Aromas of figs, dates, & Christmas cake. Rich malts dominate early on as the alcohol rips through the palate, finally subdued by flavours ripe stone fruit, spice and spiced leather. The finish is all bread, biscuits and monks' robe.		
La Trappe Quadrupel (TRAPPIST)	10.0%	750ml
Dark amber in appearance. Aromas of figs, dates, & Christmas cake. Rich malts dominate early on as the alcohol rips through the palate, finally subdued by flavours ripe stone fruit, spice and spiced leather. The finish is all bread, biscuits and monks' robe.		
Rochefort 6 (TRAPPIST)	7.5%	330ml
Rochefort 8 & 10's little brother pours a reddish amber colour, with good head retention and lacing. On the nose it displays brown sugar, chocolate and fruitcake. Flavours on the palate replicate the nose exactly, all wrapped up in no more than moderately sweet flavour profile. Mouth feel is smooth and long, with the alcohol very nicely integrated.		
Rochefort 8 (TRAPPIST)	9.2%	330ml
Mild rum alcohol in the nose, fruity with ripe banana, pear and fig. Silky smooth, creamy alcohol and malt mouth feel that glides over the tongue and down the throat. Maltiness is close to huge going from brown sugar to brownies, dark bread to mild coffee. Very complex, sweet beyond the finish.		
Westmalle Triple (TRAPPIST) -Highly recommended	9.5%	330m
Tart apricot, lemon grass, pepper, pale malts and alcohol all wrapped in a slightly pungent aroma. A bitter crisp upfront with a slick mouth feel. Many layers to this beer: fruit (ripe passion/apricot), big burst of spicy alcohol, fresh cut hay flavour, dextrin sweetness, raw honey, yeast and a slight medicinal background flavour. A very intricate brew.		
Orval (TRAPPIST)	6.2%	330ml
Orval Trappist Ale is a unique Belgian Pale Ale style and is often referred to as the "Queen of the Trappists". It was first made in 1931, and has a complex and unusual flavor and aroma produced by a unique strain of yeast. The beer is light in color, slightly cloudy, and has a large, foamy head. There is a complex aroma of leather, horse blanket, spice, and many other earthy components. One for the truly dedicated beer geek.		

Lambics...

Timmermans Peche

Abv ml

4.0% 330ml

Strong aromas of peach and dried apricot on the nose, as you might expect. A rich jammy sweetness, full of sugar and fruit. Deliciously fruity on the front palate a sweet peach jam flavour, full of ripeness. Dries out a little as it continues, but there's little pucker in the finish and zero bitterness. Warning, clapping inside your head may start when you begin drinking this beer.

Lindemans Apple

3.5% 250ml

Glowing gold in appearance, aroma is a solid ripe apple scent. Mild lambic sourness competes well with the sweet fresh apple flavour.

Lindemans Cassis

3.5% 375ml

Lambic made from barley, unmalted wheat, & wild yeast. Aged in oak after fermentation. Fresh blackcurrants are added creating a secondary fermentation, this yields an ale of exceptional flavour & complexity. Really, its adult Ribena!

Lindemans Pecherecce

2.5% 375ml

Pours with a rocky, white head that fades to a tight creamy cap the covers the sparkling golden amber glory that is "the Pecherecce". Pure, fresh peach flavours dominate. Moderate sourness follows and turns into a symphony of peach magic!

Lindemans Gueuze

5% 375ml

Pronounced "Goo-ser" this traditional lambic presents with a champagne like appearance. It has aromas of tart grain & grass followed by some "barn-yard" style phenols. Very crisp and well textured. High carbonation with a vinous dry finish. This style is a classic but is not for everyone.

Lindemans Frambroise

2.5% 375/750

Pronounced "Fram-brwa", this cheeky raspberry monkey pours a very deep pink colour with a thick light pink head. Deliberate fresh raspberry aroma & flavour so drinkable you might as well order 750ml.

Lindemans Faro

4.2% 375ml

50% old lambic & 50% new lambic is mixed with candy sugar to create this unusual beer. Solid sourness, mild apple phenols, and strong caramel/candy sugar flavours are the highlights of this lambic marvel.

Lindemans Kriek

3.5% 375ml

A well balanced lambic some say as good as the Liefmans Kriek. Smells of ripe cherries crisp tartness. Fresh cherries explode in the mouth. Not too sweet with a mild pucker at the finish.

Liefmans Goudenband -Highly recommended

8.0% 375ml

Dark hazy red beer, rich amber hues & a clumpy, bubbly off-white head. Crisp bold yeast on the nose, with faint caramel aromas. Tart up front, a bitter cherry & lime flavour to follow. The palate continues to increase in complexity as the beer warms then finishes with a dry pucker. An award winning old-school Lambic promises to represent the drinker, Belgian Style. *Food complement – as an aperitif, fresh fruit*

Morte Subite Xtreme Frambiose

4.3% 250ml

Sweet and slightly tart raspberry flavour. Very approachable and quiet fresh. Mort Subite translates to sudden death, go on take a chance.

Morte Subite Xtreme Kriek

4.3% 250ml

Maraschino cherry flavours abound, super sweet. Not the most refined lambic around but defiantly one for those with a sweet tooth.

<p>Apple skin, clean alcohol & slight yeast in the aroma. Cleansing crispness. Flashes of yeast hop bitterness & alcohol hit the palate. The beer is hopped with Styrian Goldings and Saaz hops and uses McEwans yeast. This magnum sized Duvel is very limited and only imported once a year.</p>		

Chimay Grand Reserve (Trappist)	9.0%	1500ml
<p>This vintage beer is corked in the bottle just like fine wine. Try it on your own or share with good friends.
